

MINUTES
17 June, 2000
Georgia Chapter, Vietnam Helicopter Pilots Association

The meeting was opened by the chapter president Woody McFarlin at 1040 hours with 15 members present. As is our custom, all around the table introduced themselves and gave a brief personal backgrounder.

The reading of the previous minutes was made and approved.

Future meeting sites were discussed such as Stone Mountain, Rock Springs Farm, and the Army and Navy MWR sites at Lake Allatoona. Sunday dates were also mentioned as an alternative.

Woody brought up getting a banner for the Veterans day parade. Steve Stover volunteered to head the site selection committee with Skip Davis and Jim Brennan.

On the logos we looked at the AMVETS peach on their hats as a background for the National emblem to be the Chapter logo.

A website committee of Steve Crim, Steve Stover, Terry Langille, and Chris Hawson was established. Crim suggested .org e-mail address for the chapter officers.

At 1155 hours, Steve Crim proposed the meeting close and it did.
